All prospective overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) and returning OFWs are reminded of cultural peculiarities in dealing with foreign nationals. Our penchant of overly expressing our friendliness / closeness through physical contact or “touching” (“pagkalabit” o “pagyakap-yakap” o “paghawak-hawak”) may be wrongfully interpreted as “sexual harassment” or “sexual advances” or uncalled for friendliness.

This advisory is being issued to prevent future repetition of such incident, which ended up with a female Filipino nurse in London, England being haled to court but was fortunately proven innocent of the charge of “sexual harassment”.
