
TO : ALL OWWA REGIONAL WELFARE OFFICES CONDUCTING PDOS

SUBJECT : NON-ADMISSION TO PDOS OF NEWLY HIRED KUWAIT-BOUND WORKERS

DATE : 17 JANUARY 2020

In line with the Philippine Overseas Employment Administration (POEA) Governing Board Resolution No. 04, Series of 2020 imposing a total ban on the processing and deployment of domestic workers or household service workers, semi-skilled workers, skilled-workers and professionals, including crew changes and shore leaves of Filipino seafarers in Kuwait, all OWWA Regional Welfare Offices (RWOs) conducting Pre-Departure Orientation Seminar (PDOS)/Comprehensive Pre-Departure Education Program (CPDEP) are advised to refrain from accepting endorsements for attending PDOS from the Philippine Recruitment Agencies (PRAs) of domestic workers bound to the said country.
